EWS Tool Reports

- Look at data at three levels:
 - School
 - Students
 - Individual students
- Sort data in multiple ways:
 - Time periods (e.g., quarters, semesters, trimesters)
 - Student characteristics (e.g., English Language Learners, students with disabilities, etc.)
 - Cohorts
- Assign students to interventions and monitor progress



Selected Reports Demonstrated Today



- Step 3 Review EWS Data
 - Student Risk Status Page
- Step 4 Interpret the EWS data
 - Risk Indicator Summary Report:ELL
- Step 5 Assign and provide interventions
 - Detailed Student Report
- Step 6 Monitor students
 - Intervention Summary Report
- Step 7 Evaluate and Refine
 - Enrollment Status Summary Report
